UNIFORM POLICY

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Carnegie uniform consists of a gold or yellow shirt/blouse with a collar and navy or dark blue pants or skirt. A complete uniform consist of students wearing ties and black or navy blue leather dress shoes. A student may also wear Carnegie sweat gear in lieu of formal uniform only on gym days. Hats and jackets are not allowed once the students are in the building. Solid blue or gold sweaters may be worn. Other clothing or items **not permitted** on school property include:

- Bandanas, doo-rags, tams
- Male students are not permitted to wear earrings
- Flip flops
- Large items of jewelry
- Athletic bands (wrist, head, etc.)
- Colored shoelaces
- Hoodie sweatshirts
- Multi-colored socks (girls)

All students are expected to wear their uniform to school every day. Students will not be able to participate in extra-curricular activities or privileges (recess, sports, after school programs, classroom helper, etc.) for habitual uniform violations. Please be sure to send your child to school in complete uniform daily.

First Violation:	Student will be issued a warning
Second Violation	Parent will be notified by phone or email
Third Violation	Student will receive a detention
+ Violations	Student will be excluded from recess and/or extra-curricular activities.
